The Fund seeks a combination of income and capital appreciation. Amundi Climate Transition Core Bond Fund is a multi-sector fixed income portfolio that invests in a diversified\* range of fixed income sectors with the goal of pursuing competitive returns—compared to a traditional higher-quality US core fixed-income portfolio—without excessive additional volatility. The Fund provides a meaningful approach to creating a reduced carbon footprint portfolio over time, while investing in companies we believe are best positioned to contribute to a lower carbon economy. Over time, the portfolio will pursue continued and measurable progress toward lower carbon outcomes and a strong performance objective relative to the benchmark.

Average Life is the average time until a dollar of principal is repaid. **Duration** is a measure of the sensitivity of the price (the value of principal) of a fixed income investment to a change in interest rates, expressed as a number of years. **Effective Duration** (also called option-adjusted duration) is a duration calculation for bonds that have embedded options.
